- Worked on the BrightHouse.com redesign project, created image assets for the **CMS**, migrated copy and **Flash** assets from the old site. Updated the **Flash** assets to allow setting paths and values using flashvars, as well as correcting existing bugs and interface problems with the old **Flash** assets. Corrected specific browser rendering issues, which were reported by the QA team.
- Changed the existing **jQuery** modal implementation to allow for .flv and .swf files to open in a modal window from direct links to the files. Extended this functionality to other types of dynamic images such as Google static maps API images, and later updated to allow for inline html content.
- Created reusable **XHTML/CSS** snippets, such as multi step wizard controls and contextual error panels for use by programmers in the multiple applications that make up the site.

McMurry, Web Designer, Longwood, FL (Originally Cyrus, acquired in 2009) June 2007 – January 2010

- Designed comps based on a hospital, clinic, physician, and/or the corporate parent company's wishes and sliced them using Photoshop. Built out the comps using XHTML/CSS for use in a custom in-house medical industry centered CMS.
- Created custom templates for the in-house CMS using ASP.Net master pages. JavaScript and jQuery were used for interactivity, photo slide shows, and special effects. Occasionally jQuery was used to bypass the limitations of the CMS and to inject text or HTML where it would not normally be possible with the CMS's normal features.
- For larger clients, produced a stand-alone solution for multiple micro sites using nested master pages, shared CSS and image files for the many common assets to allow for easy updating of images and styles across all sites. Each micro site also had its own separate CSS and image files for customization separate from the common styles.
- Flash animation and coding with ActionScript 2. Cross browser embedding with SWFobject.
- New features for the medical sites were continually added and needed XHTML and CSS coding. The front-end additions had corresponding admin site additions with forms that required further styling.

- Researched, built, and styled hospital modules for career opportunities, patient e-cards, and online job application submissions.
- Designed the admin site and occasionally redesigned it based on client suggestions. Re-skinned the admin site once the company was acquired to match the McMurry branding and intranet site.
- Created reusable Google Maps API code for use on location and contact pages. Collaborated with team members to create a zip code location lookup page.
